We will start by going on a short drive, only 10km south from Kenya's pulsing capital, to Nairobi National Park, also called "The World's Wildlife Capital", the home of over 400 species of animals. If luck comes your way, you will be able to see four of the 'The Big Five'.

As we drive around the park, your eyes will meet the impressive skyscrapers of Nairobi in the backdrop of wildlife and nature - this sight is nothing but incredible! Furthermore, you will get to see the roaring river of Mbagathi where you might spot a crocodile or a hippo.

Opposite the Nairobi National Park is Kitengela Glass, 'a magical place in the bush' at the end of a rough road. Here you will see recycled glass and other materials transformed right before your eyes into beautiful artworks. The products are both functional and stylish objects made with pure passion. For the adventurous, you may cross the boardwalk, a rickety swaying bridge, across the 200 meter ravine. People visit this place from around the world because Kitengela Glass is not just a place or a product - it's an experience!
